

ASPCart 3.05 Installation Instructions

STEP 1

Copy the following files into your server's root directory. Make sure you do not overwrite existing files of the same name:

addcart.asp
qtyupd.asp
viewcart.asp
emptycart.asp
checkout.asp
payment.asp
mailto.exe (E-mail processing / formatting script)
thankyou.htm
aspcart2.mdb (Microsoft Access Database where info is stored)

... plus, all included .GIF images (there are five).

- There is a working DEMO STORE contained in the DEMO.ZIP file. This demo replaces some of the above .ASP files, but will not adversely affect anything. You may either place it in a subdirectory called "demo" or in your document root.

Next, you or your system administrator will need to create an ODBC data source for ASPCart. A SYSTEM DSN must be created. The name of the System DSN should be "aspcart" and should be mapped to the location where "aspcart.mdb" resides (usually your home directory).

STEP 2

Open "aspcart2.mdb" into Microsoft Access and add your products to the table named "products" following the examples.

STEP 3 (FINAL STEP)

The final step is to instruct ASPCart where to E-mail the results of the order form.

Open the file "payment.asp" into a text editor and modify lines 160 and 161 to contain your own E-mail address and your ISP's mail server. Be sure to request permission from your ISP to use their mail server.

If you have flat rate shipping, you may open "checkout.asp" into an HTML editor to adjust the default rates. If you use dynamic shipping rates (based on order total, weight, etc) please see the next section in this documentation.
