

ASPCart 4.05 for Microsoft® SQL Server 7.0 Installation Instructions

STEP 1 – Installation

Copy the following files from the archive into a web-accessible folder on the server that you are using. Make sure you do not overwrite existing files of the same name.

A demo store is provided (Bikerbob's Bicycle Shop). In an effort to conserve space, none of the product image files have been included.

A new database must be created on the SQL server. You can use Microsoft Access 2000 as a GUI to import the table structure of aspcart.mdb into this newly created database. The name of this database should be set to "bikerbob" for the demo to work properly. The username and password should also be set to "bikerbob".

You or your system administrator will need to create a "System DSN" (not a User DSN) for ASPCart 4.05 on the web server using the "ODBC" applet in the Windows control panel. To activate the demo, the name of the System DSN should be "bikerbob". This DSN should use the SQL driver and should be mapped to the SQL server that you are using either named pipes or a TCP/IP socket connection. The username and password of "bikerbob" should be used for the DSN initially.

STEP 2 (FINAL STEP)

The final step is to instruct ASPCart where to E-mail the results of the order form.

Open the file "payment.asp" into a text editor and modify the "hidden" input lines to contain your own E-mail address and your ISP's mail server. Be sure to request permission from your ISP to use their mail server.

To enter shipping rates and your home state tax rate, you may open "checkout.asp" into an HTML editor to adjust the default rates.

Shipping Rates / Customization (optional)

Because all business' methods for shipping rate calculation vary, a custom algorithm can be programmed into ASPCart in order for it to calculate shipping
